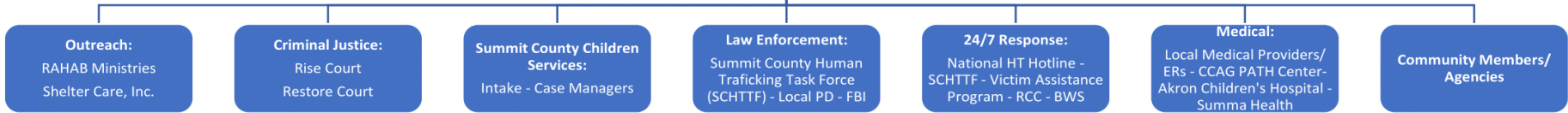

How is a victim identified?



Response:
Prioritize the self-determination of the survivor. If the client is a minor, a report must be made to Children’s Services.

Law Enforcement:
If you need immediate, on-scene response, would like to make a report, or suspect local trafficking activity, contact the Summit County Human Trafficking Task Force: 330-252-2614. Victim Advocacy is also available through SCHTTF.

National Human Trafficking Hotline:
If you want to report a tip, or you suspect trafficking and don’t need an immediate, local law enforcement response, call 1-888-373-7888 or text HELP to BEFREE (233733). These tips may not trigger local law enforcement response.

Follow-Up Services for Survivors:
Prioritize the self-determination of the survivor. If the client is a minor, a report must be made to Children’s Services. Refer to the SCCAHT Service Matrix for provider names and contact info.
